Our fiscal year is now through June 2006 and we are accepting applications. Mentees are matched to mentors that can assist them in their learning objectives, and one-on-one meetings are scheduled between them. There are up to 15 hours of mentorship to use before June 2006.

New and seasoned staff have experienced many benefits to participating in this program. Administrators as well as direct service personnel are eligible to apply. The goal of the program is to increase the quality of services that young children (0-6 years) with special needs receive.
